

HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION ANNOUNCEMENT SH 52 between SH 119 and US 287

Project Overview

On September 6, 2011, the Colorado Department of Transportation will begin a 4.5-mile resurfacing project on State Highway (SH) 52 (Mineral Road), between SH 119 and US 287. The \$3.2 million project will be complete by the end of January 2012, weather permitting.

Anticipated Delays and Restrictions

Single lane closures are planned throughout the project and most of the work will take place at night to minimize the impacts to traffic. Single lane closures are possible from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Thursday nights.

Speed limits will be reduced to 40 MPH through the construction zone and oversized vehicles will be restricted during work times. Fines for most infractions that occur in the construction zone will be doubled.
